Re: City Council Meeting, November 25 Agenda Item 7.1 - North Bayshore Precise Plan

Dear Mayor Clark and Members of the City Council:

The LWV would like to comment on the North Bayshore Precise Plan (NBS PP). We urge the Council not to approve the plan as it stands today because the proposed benefits do not outweigh the environmental impacts, in our opinion, primarily due to the lack of housing included in the plan.

Transportation issues are obviously a major problem in the North Bayshore area, but the specific transportation improvements detailed in the staff report, such as the Shoreline off-ramp realignment, could be accomplished before waiting for new developments to provide funds. City funds along with regional/state grants are potential sources for proceeding quickly with some of the City's Capital Improvement Programs for North Bayshore. Thus, we believe the current transportation situation could be improved while further study is done on the housing options for North Bayshore.

Allowing additional housing in North Bayshore was the environmentally superior alternative in the General Plan study. Many infrastructure resources are close to North Bayshore, including schools and a grocery store, and improvements to the Shoreline/101 overcrossing will make these resources easier to access. In addition, North Bayshore traffic is extremely directional, and any reverse commute traffic from additional residents will not increase congestion (not to mention the reductions from employees who live and work in North Bayshore). Thus, we believe adding additional housing is feasible. We urge the City to reconsider this alternative, particularly since the jobs/housing imbalance continues to worsen, and jobs being added to the North Bayshore area are a major contributor to this problem. While allowing additional housing in North Bayshore would not be a total solution, it could play a significant role in alleviating the housing shortage. Therefore, we urge the Council not to approve the plan as it stands and to deny the EIR.
